The 9 storey commercial office building has 3 levels of underground carpark, a cafe, gymnasium and will be the new home for Fujitsu and their 900 staff members. Highlights of the project include:

- High performance, thermally broken, double glazed facade with 5.2 kilometres of vertical and horizontal sunshades

- Public Domain upgrade including replacement of street lights, undergrounding overhead power lines and replacement of all concrete footpaths with Black Granite pavers

- 2 internal stairs linking all floors of fitout
