Set across three floors within the iconic Anzac Square Building, heritage elements include mouldings, bulkheads and marble are prominently incorporated throughout. The scope includes a central concierge and reception area, a large communal kitchen, breakout games area, private offices, meeting rooms and boardrooms, and open-plan working spaces.
